

Rules and Other Information for NIESHOUTKLOOF (Die Wortel, Aragon's Villa and Wildsfees)

- » Check In Time: 14h00, Check Out Time 11h00
- » Note that special arrangements can be made if necessary. Children are welcome, but needs to be supervised at all times.
- » Use of all facilities, including but not limited to dams, shuttle service, etc. is at your OWN RISK
- » Management/Owner do not take ANY responsibility for the loss of possessions and/or life, for any damage to personal property by other people or animals and/or theft or injury occurred while you are on the property.
- » Note that we make use of Septic Tanks Please, therefore do not dispose of sanitary towels or foreign objects in the toilets

- » Note that we make use of gas geysers and/or 'donkies' to heat the water at Die Wortel's ablution facilities. Be aware that the irrigation system in the Sundays River Valley is a canal system. The farm is however, fully fenced off from the canal. **Re-iterate to everyone in your group that swimming in the canal is NOT permitted.**
- » This is a water saving environment.
- » The speed limit is 20km per hour on the premises.
- » Rubbish bins are provided at various locations – please make use of them DO NOT LITTER
- » Be aware that there are monkeys around and that they could steal your food and/or possessions. Do not feed ANY animals encountered on the farm.
- » Be aware that we have wildlife in the enclosed camps on both sides of the fence.
- » Be careful when you are in the veld as there could be bushpig, leopards, scorpions, snakes etc. which could pose a danger to you and your party.
- » Pets are permitted by prior arrangement only
